## SHOW RULES, PROCEDURES AND REGULATIONS

This show is licensed by the Governing Council of the Cat Fancy and is open to all. Copies of the GCCF Rules are available from the GCCF Office, 5 King's Castle Business Park, The Drove, Bridgwater, Somerset TA6 4AG. Please make sure you read and understand these rules and the schedule before entering the show. **IGNORANCE OF ANY RULE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AS EXCUSE OF ITS BREACH.**

### ELIGIBILITY OF EXHIBITS TO ENTER SHOW

All Cats, Kitten and Neuters must be registered with the GCCF. To be effective for entry, all registrations must have reach the GCCF Office, 5 King's Castle Business Park, The Drove, Bridgwater, Somerset, TA6 4AG, at least 21 days prior t the Show date Cats with unregistered parents but which are themselves registered (on June 1st, 1971) and which are eligible for Challenge Certificates on that date shall continue to be so and so shall their suitable progeny for three generations from 20 October 1971. Thereafter, only cats with registered parents, grandparents and great-grandparents shall be eligible.

### MAKING A SHOW ENTRY

In order to exhibit at this show, you must complete the official show entry form, and read and sign the declaration where indicated. Exhibitors are responsible for the correct description of their exhibits, and for entering them in the correct classes. The information on the entry form must be identical to that on your exhibit's registration or transfer form, except for the addition of GCCF titles. **If you make any mistakes your exhibit may be disqualified.** This can result from incorrect or incomplete details of exhibit/owner/sire/dam/breeder, such as incorrect sex, breed, date of birth where this affects the class entry, omission of Prefix, single ownership when it should be joint or vice versa, ownership different from that recorded with GCCF. If you are entering several cats from your household and the owners differ within the household/family, please use a separate form for each owner. In the case of joint ownership only one entry form should be used, and both owners must sign the form. Cats which are not normally resident with their registered owner should be transferred into the ownership of their keeper if they are to be shown If the registration form has not been received at the time of entry, fill in the name you have applied for, and write RAF (Registration Applied For) in the registration number box on the form. When you receive your registration form notify the Show Managers, in writing, of the registration number and any change of name. If you are entering a cat on exhibition the entry form must be completed exactly the same as for a cat in competition, marking the class number in the Open Class Box. No exhibit may be entered into more than 10 classes. Neutered Kittens must be entered in the appropriate Kitten Classes. **If you enter your kitten as entire and he/she is neutered before show day you must inform the Show Manager immediately.** Exhibits entered in the wrong class will be disqualified from the class concerned, and it may not be possible to move them to the correct class on show day. **Judges may disqualify exhibits which are not the colour stated on the entry form, so if you change the registered colour of your exhibit before show day, you must inform the Show Manager as soon as possible. There is no 21 day limit on this.** Show Managers are permitted to accept alteration, at their own discretion, on show day up to the close of the show; such a change must not be a change of exhibit

**Finally before posting your entry please double check that you have signed the form and enclosed the correct entry fee. Any entries which are incorrect will be returned and the resulting delay may mean that you are too late to enter. You will not be allowed to sign your entry form, or pay entry monies, on show day so If you have any queries about your entry, or require assistance please contact the Show Managers. Have the schedule, your entry form, and your exhibit's registration details to hand when you make the call.**

## WITHDRAWALS

All withdrawals must be made in writing. The last date for withdrawals is the published closing date of the show, after this date the exhibit may not be withdrawn from the catalogue, and the 13 day rule will apply. This ruling does not prevent Show Managers from returning entries after the closing date of the show if they are unable to accept them because the show is full. At the discretion of the Committee, a percentage of entry fees may be refunded if your exhibit is withdrawn on Veterinary advice, provided that a Veterinary Certificate is received by the Show Manager at least 7 days before the date of the show.

## ON ARRIVAL AT THE SHOW

Exhibits will be received into the show hall from 8.00 am until 9.45 am on the morning of the show. All exhibits must be brought to the show in secure containers (top opening recommended), and must be accompanied by their owner or owner's representative. Each exhibit will be examined by the Club's Honorary Veterinary Surgeons. If an exhibit cannot easily be removed from the container, he/she may not be vetted in. No exhibit may be penned before being examined. Any exhibit which, in the opinion of the Duty Veterinary Surgeon, is unfit, in poor condition or undersized for its age will be rejected. Exhibits must be free of parasites, show no sign of skin lesions or the use of drugs. Ears and coats must be clean. Entire males over the age of 9 months of age will not be accepted if they are either monorchid or cryptorchid. Cats who have been declawed may not be exhibited. Queens who are pregnant, lactating, or who have kitted within the last 12 weeks may not be exhibited. Blind cats may not be shown. **Exhibits are received on condition that the Club shall not be held responsible for any loss or damage to exhibits, carriers or other property.**

All exhibits must be vaccinated against FIE (Enteritis), FVR and FCV (Cat Flu): the full course of vaccination, in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations, must have been completed at least 7 days before the date of the show, and clearly show the identity of the exhibit and owner. The Certificate must have been issued by a Veterinary Practice/Hospital and the last vaccination entry signed by a Veterinary Surgeon or by a listed Veterinary Nurse under the direction of a Veterinary Surgeon. Cats with an invalid vaccination certificate will be rejected under Section A. Cats without a vaccination certificate will also be rejected under Section A unless the exhibitor undertakes to provide proof of vaccination by sending the certificate to the GCCF Office within 7 days of the show. Failure to do so will lead to disqualification from the show, and the cat's name being placed on the rejection list until such proof is received in the Office. Homeopathic vaccination cannot be accepted. Exhibitors are reminded that in the event of rejection, all exhibits in the same registered ownership may also be rejected, and clearance may be required for both households. **THE DUTY VETERINARY SURGEON'S DECISION IS FINAL.**

**N.B.** No animals or pets will be allowed into the show hall other than exhibiting Cats, Kittens and Neuters.

## VETERINARY CLEARANCE CERTIFICATES

If your exhibit has been rejected or disqualified by a Veterinary Surgeon, the Show Manager shall notify the GCCF within 48 hrs of the show, and forward a copy of the rejection form to you. Exhibitors whose cats have been rejected at shows should note the following points:

1. When sending your clearance certificate to the GCCF Office, please include your copy of the rejection form.
2. Do not send certificates by recorded delivery as this can cause delays in receipt. If acknowledgment is required, enclose a stamped addressed postcard for stamping by the GCCF Office as confirmation of receipt.
3. You should not attend shows until you have received a letter from the office accepting and confirming clearance. Take this letter with you to any shows which you attend within 1 month of its issue.

## PRESENTATION AND BENCHING OF EXHIBITS

Exhibitor's passes, catalogue vouchers and prize money slips will be issued at vetting in. There will be no tallies at this show, so please make sure that your exhibit is in the correct pen before judging starts. **White show equipment, litter etc. will be on sale in the show hall.** Your exhibit should be presented with pride. Make sure he/she is comfortable, warm and relaxed. Each exhibit must have clean white blankets of reasonable size to lie on (cellular blankets and sewn cat beds are not allowed but white Vet-Bed or like material may be used if preferred), a white litter tray (with litter), a white water container (with fresh water), and a white food bowl. The water bowl must stay in the pen all day, but the food bowl must be removed before judging starts at 10.00 am, and not replaced until after 12.30 pm. Hot water bottles/heat reflecting material/cool packs are the only form of heating/cooling aids allowed, and must be covered by the blankets. Battery driven fans are not allowed. No item of show equipment in competition pens must bear any distinguishing marks. Judges are instructed to pass any pen that is distinguished in any manner. No written or printed matter of any kind, other than official notices and award cards may be put onto competitive pens. The use of grooming aids, other than a clean brush, comb or cloth is not allowed. Sprays, aerosols or toxic disinfectants may not be used in the show hall. Powder or grooming substances must not be left in the coats of exhibits. Exhibitors are reminded that some shampoos sold for use with cats contain colouring matter, and the use of such products could lead to disqualification. Also the use of any product, including skullcap & valerian, rescue remedy, sedatives for travel etc., which changes a cat's normal appearance or physical reaction is not allowed at GCCF shows.

Once received into the show hall exhibits may not be removed without the permission of the Show Manager. Nobody may remove an exhibit from its pen except the owner, owner's representative or show official. Exhibitors may not carry their exhibits around the show hall or hold them in such a way as to upset other exhibits. Exhibitors must be within call throughout the period of the show, except during the time the hall is cleared for judging. The show closes at 5.00 pm, or earlier at the Show Manager's discretion, and no exhibit may be removed from its pen before this time. Failure to observe this rule may lead to disqualification and forfeiture of any prizes awarded. There will be no early passes.

## OWNER'S LIABILITY FOR VETERINARY TREATMENT AT SHOWS

Exhibitors (owners) are responsible for the cost of any veterinary treatment required by their cat (s) during their absence from the show hall.

## **JUDGING AND JUDGES**

Judging will commence at 10.00 am and exhibitors will be asked to clear the hall until 12.30 pm. Judges are empowered to withhold any prize, award or certificate in any class if an exhibit does not, in their opinion possess sufficient merit. Prizes will be awarded from the judges slip only. THE JUDGE'S DECISION IS FINAL. An exhibitor may not enter into any conversation with a judge until that judge's engagement is complete.

### **CHAMPION AND PREMIER TITLES**

The title of Champion shall be granted to entire cats winning three Challenge Certificates, under three different judges. A GCCF Challenge Certificate will be offered for each Adult Open Class with Championship status. The title of Premier shall be granted to neutered cats under the same rules and conditions as for Champions.

### **GRAND CHAMPION AND GRAND PREMIER TITLES**

The title of Grand Champion shall be granted to entire cats winning three Grand Challenge Certificates, under three different judges. To enter a Grand Challenge Class a cat must be a full Champion by the published closing date for the show. A GCCF Grand Challenge Certificate will be offered, with a Reserve in case of disqualification. A Champion may also enter its appropriate breed Open Class. The title of Grand Premier shall be granted to neutered cats under the same rules and conditions as for Grand Champions.

### **IMPERIAL GRAND CHAMPION AND IMPERIAL GRAND PREMIER TITLES**

The title of Imperial Grand Champion shall be granted to entire cats winning five Imperial Grand Challenge Certificates, under five different judges. To enter an Imperial Grand Challenge Class a cat must be a full Grand Champion by the published closing date for the show, A GCCF Imperial Grand Challenge Certificate will be offered, with a Reserve in case of disqualification. A cat entered in the Imperial Grand Champion Class may also enter, either its appropriate breed Open Class, or the Grand Champion Class, but not both. The title of Imperial Grand Premier shall be granted to neutered cats under the same rules and conditions as for Imperial Grand Champions.

### **COUNTERSIGNING OF CERTIFICATES**

If your Open Class Judge is changed after the closing date of the show, and the replacement Judge has already awarded a Certificate to your cat, another Judge will be appointed to consider your cat for countersignature if it is awarded the Certificate, PROVIDED YOU TELL THE SHOW MANAGER BEFORE JUDGING STARTS.

Countersigned Certificates count towards a title, or qualification of Preliminary status breeds. If the replacement judge at this show has also been previously booked for a subsequent show, the closing date of which is before the date of this show, then at the subsequent show this judge can be considered as a replacement judge for the purpose of requesting a countersignature.

## THE COMMITTEE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO:

1. Appoint other judges should those advertised be unable to fulfil their engagement, and to appoint further judges should they be required.
2. Fix and limit the number of exhibits at the show, and to accept or refuse entry without giving reasons.
3. Cancel, amalgamate or divide classes.
4. Publish a catalogue of the show containing information as to the exhibits, together with the names and addresses of exhibitors, and process this information by computer.
5. Retain a percentage of the entry fees, to cover essential expenses, in the event of the show being cancelled for any reason.

## DEFINITION OF CLASSES

(All definitions apply to shows held under GCCF Rules)

<b>OPEN CLASS:</b>	Open to all of the specified Breed.
<b>IMPERIAL GR CH:</b>	Adults of full Grand Champion status only.
<b>IMPERIAL GR PR:</b>	Neuters of full Grand Premier status only.
<b>GRAND CHAMPION:</b>	Adults of full Champion status only.
<b>GRAND PREMIER:</b>	Neuters of full Premier status only.
<b>ADULTS:</b>	Not less than 9 months on show day. Born before 7.2.10..
<b>KITTENS:</b>	Not less than 14 weeks, and under 9 months on show day. Born between 7.2.10 and 31.7.10 inclusive. Neutered kittens must be entered in Kitten Open & Miscellaneous Classes.
<b>NEUTERS:</b>	Neutered adults may only enter Classes specified for Neuters.
<b>NOVICE:</b>	Exhibits that have not won a first prize in any class at a GCCF show.
<b>ARISTOCRAT:</b>	Exhibits which have one or more CCs or PCs, but are not full Champions or Premiers.
<b>LIMIT:</b>	Exhibits that have not won more than four first prizes in any class at a show held under GCCF Rules.
<b>DEBUTANTE:</b>	Exhibits that have never been shown at a show held under GCCF Rules.
<b>MAIDEN:</b>	Exhibits that have not won a first, second or third prize in any class at a show held under GCCF Rules.
<b>BREEDERS:</b>	Exhibits bred by the exhibitor, Cats originally registered in the breeders joint ownership, but changed to single ownership of one of the breeders can still be entered in this class. Cats originally registered in the breeders single ownership, and changed to joint ownership with the breeder should be entered in the Non-Breeders Class.
<b>ADOLESCENT:</b>	Over 9 months and under 15 months on show day. Born between 7.8.09 and 6.2.10 inclusive.
<b>JUNIOR:</b>	Over 9 months and under 2 years on show day. Born between 7.11.08 and 6.2.10 inclusive.
<b>SENIOR:</b>	2 years and over on show day. Born before 7.11.09.
<b>VETERAN:</b>	7 years and over on show day. Born before 7.11.03.

**Notes:**

1. The status of the exhibit for entering restricted classes (Maiden etc.) shall be the exhibits status on the day of entry. Except that to be eligible for entry into the Imperial Grand Champion/Grand Champion Classes, the status of Grand Champion/Champion must be attained before the published closing date in this schedule. The same rule applies to neuters.
2. Wins as a kitten so not count when the exhibit is shown as an Adult or Neuter. Wins as an Adult do not count when the exhibit is neutered and shown. Merit awards do not count as wins for entering restricted classes.
3. **Please note that in addition to the classes you have entered, your cat may also be handled for the purpose of assessing candidates in the GCCF Judge Appointment Scheme.**

**STATUS OF ERRORS - WHAT TO EXPECT**

**MINOR ERRORS.** These warrant a notification for your reference if the error occurs more than once and it is apparent that registration details were available at the time of entry or before the date of the Show. Continuous repetition of the same error after notification will be referred to the Executive Committee. Examples of minor errors include:

- a) Spelling errors.
- b) Separation of cat's name that should be one word and vice versa.
- c) Administrative/breeder's prefix omitted from, or partially incorrect name given for, exhibit.
- d) Overseas title preceding the name of an exhibit, sire or dam, etc.
- e) Full breed number known but not given.  
Sire and Dam reversed or named incorrectly.  
Breeder joint when single and vice versa.

**INCORRECT DATE OF BIRTH.** This is usually classed as a minor error unless it affects an entry into classes based on age groups, when it could warrant disqualification of the exhibit from such classes, but if the incorrect date of birth affects the age suitability as a whole, then the exhibit will be disqualified from the Show.

**N.B. AGE LIMITS:** Kittens not less than 14 weeks and under 9 calendar months on date of Show,  
Adults not less than 9 calendar months on date of Show

**INCORRECT NAME OF EXHIBIT/OWNER/BREEDER**

If registration/transfer details were obviously available at the time of entry or before the date of the Show, disqualification is inevitable. The following discrepancies are those which usually arise :-

**N.B.** The breeder of a cat is **always** the registered owner of the dam on the date of the cat's birth.

**REGISTRATION/TRANSFER NOT RECEIVED BY GCCF 21 DAYS BEFORE THE DATE OF THE SHOW.**

These entries will be disqualified. Remember, the effective date of all registrations and transfers is **the first date of valid receipt by the GCCF**, and if you enclose your own stamped addressed acknowledgement card with your application form this will be stamped with the GCCF Office date of receipt.

**TRANSFER OF EXHIBIT FROM EXHIBITOR TO A NEW OWNER RECEIVED BY GCCF MORE THAN 21 DAYS BEFORE THE DATE OF THE SHOW.**

Entries such as these will also be disqualified as the Exhibitor's entry form becomes invalid.

**INCORRECT CLASS ENTRY.** These will be disqualified from the class concerned - so always check with the Show Manager if in doubt about which class to enter. If a breed number is changed officially, it is important that you notify the Show Manager immediately. Exhibits entered in Grand classes must have gained their title before the published closing date of the show.

**CAT REGISTERED ON THE REFERENCE REGISTER.** No Cat registered on this Register is eligible to be shown and, therefore, these entries will be disqualified. The only exception to this is when a new breed becomes recognised; and then, cats of the breed may be shown even if they are registered on the Reference

Register as long as this was the only reason for the Reference registration.

Exhibitors may appeal against any disqualification resulting from the Show checking, giving their reasons. The appeal will be referred to the Executive Committee if considered valid and, if not, a letter of explanation will be sent to the exhibitor(s). The above advice, however, is aimed to keep your show entries trouble-free, not to mention the show checking.

**ENTRY FEES**

**PEDIGREE AND NON-PEDIGREE SECTIONS**

**THE FEES COVER 4 CLASSES, AND ONE ENTRY PASS PER EXHIBITOR, (JOINT EXHIBITORS ONE PASS ONLY). ENTRY TO THE IMPERIAL GRAND & GRAND CLASS IS FREE. EXHIBITS ENTERED INTO EITHER OR BOTH OF THESE CLASSES MAY STILL BE ENTERED IN FOUR OTHER CLASSES FOR THE BASIC FEE.**

## **BEST IN SHOW**

To be considered for Best in Show cats must be nominated by a judge. To be eligible for nomination an exhibit must have either:

1. Won its Open, Grand or Imperial Grand Class, if an adult or neuter, and been awarded the Certificate, or have won Best of Breed or Best Opposite Sex if not entered in its Open class.  
Won its open class if a kitten or kitten neuter. Best of Breed or Best Opposite Sex must have been awarded, although the kitten may be of a different age group to the BOB/BOX winner.

Trophies will be awarded to members' cats winning Best in Show.

## **CORRESPONDENCE**

All correspondence must be accompanied by a S.A.E. if a reply is required. Any complaint related to the show must be forwarded to the Show Manager within 7 days of the show.

## **ACCESS FOR THE HANDICAPPED**

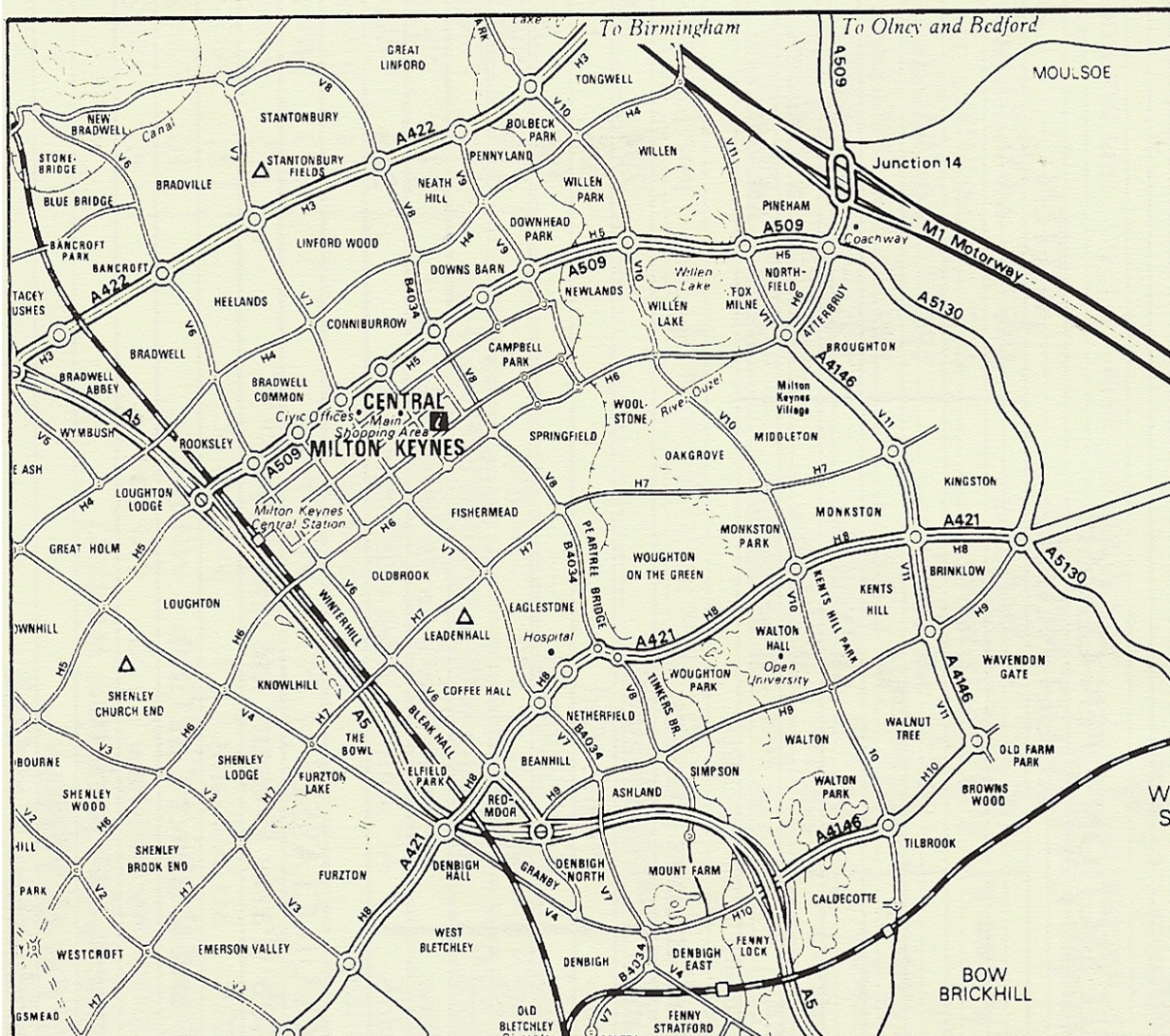
